MEMORANDUM FOR MISSISSIPPI WING MEMBERS

SUBJECT: Operations Order for Wing Campout and Search and Rescue Exercise Weekend

1. **DESCRIPTION:** The Mississippi Wing Cadet Advisory Council has selected to host a Wing Campout and Search and Rescue Exercise on the weekend of March 23-25, in conjunction with the Wing Search and Rescue Exercise. This campout will feature emergency services training, with specific focus on Ground Team Member Level 3 tasks, and a safe and fun environment for cadets from across the Wing to come together and get to know each other to further our training and dedication to the Cadet Program and the Mississippi Wing.
2. **APPLICATION:** Applications will open up Thursday March 1 and will close Wednesday March 14. To apply, please go to [www.mswg.cap.gov](http://www.mswg.cap.gov) and follow the Eventbrite link where you can pay. If you are applying for staff, please contact the appropriate person below to make sure we have a spot for you before going to Eventbrite. Once you contact the appropriate officer, they will let you know when you may apply on Eventbrite.
3. **ELIGIBILITY:** This will be a cadet run and hosted activity under the supervision of Senior Members. Instructors will consist of both Senior Members and cadets, both meeting National and Wing certifications and regulations to teach Ground Team tasks.
  - a. **Cadet Staff**
    - i. If you are a cadet interested in staffing, you must be at least Ground Team Member 3 certified as well as have your SET certification on your 101 card.     - b. If you are a Senior Member and are interested in helping to supervise, please contact Capt Paul Kloehn ([pkloehn@desotocap.org](mailto:pkloehn@desotocap.org)). If you are interested in instructing, you must be Ground Team Member 3 or Ground Team Leader certified as well as have your SET certification on your 101 card. Please send all applications to Capt Kloehn.
4. **TRANSPORTATION:** Transportation to and from the activity is not the responsibility of CAP and is provided "as available." Privately owned vehicles used to travel to or from such an activity is performed strictly at the member's own risk (reference CAPR 77-1, para 6c and CAPR 52-16, para 8-10) and is not under CAP direction and control. Transportation during the activity will NOT be provided.
5. **LODGING INFORMATION:** Participants, cadet and senior member staff, and any supervisors are responsible for their own lodging. This will be a campground, and staying in a tent is highly encouraged. Cadets may share tents, room provided, but this must be worked

out prior to the activity. Under no circumstances will cadets billet with senior members and at no time will any member billet with a member of the opposite gender.

6. **MEALS:** Meals will be provided by senior staff through the cost of the activity. Meal plans will be thought of and pre-prepared by designated senior staff.
7. **UNIFORM:** The uniform for the activity will be the Battle Dress Uniform (BDU). Members are required to bring enough undergarments and socks for two nights and three days, and an extra uniform if available. Members not meeting the height and weight standards are required to wear the alternate uniforms per CAPM 39-1.
8. **EQUIPMENT LIST:** The equipment list will be furnished at the time of application. It will consist of basic 24 hour gear and required safety paraphernalia to comply with CAP safety regulations.
9. **MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES:** Members are responsible for the following:
  - a. Transportation to/from and during the activity.
  - b. Follow all CAP regulatory publications
  - c. Conduct of all members of their selves, sponsors, and spectators.
