Flight Cap	1	With CAP device

Blues Short Sleeve Shirt	1

Rank/Grade Insignia	1 pair	
Nametag, Ribbon, Badges	1	
Shirt-stays	1 pair	As desired: they do increase the sharpness of a uniform
White V-Neck	2	
Blues Pants or Skirt	1	
Belt and Buckle	1	Blue, cotton web or elastic, solid or woven with plain chrome buckle
Dress Socks / Black or Hosiery	2	Socks for low quarters and hosiery for pumps/flats
Black Low Quarters or Pumps/Flats	1	Can be corfram/hi-gloss or leather (should be at least lightly polished)
ABU Uniform	Will be required for TAC officers, CAP Field Uniform can be substituted if SM does not meet AF	
Cover	Optional	Senior members will be issued black ball caps to wear with working and field uniforms. If sun exposure is a concern you can bring a black wide-brim tactical hat.
Rank/Grade Insignia	1	One metal pin to be attached to encampment issued ball cap.
ABU Coat/Blouse	2	With Civil Air Patrol and last name nametape, and insignia firmly attached
T-Shirt / Desert Tan	4-7	Crew neck, short sleeves, can be cotton or a quick-drying material
ABU Trousers	2	
Desert Tan Rigger Belt	1	
Black Boot Socks	7 pairs	Should be taller than boots, it is best if socks are in good working order, quick-drying, and fit nicely to help prevent blisters
Blousing Bands	2 pairs	
Black Combat Boots	1	Should be broken in to prevent blisters
Corporate Working Uniform	Optional	
Polo		Encampment gets hot and you will get sweaty. Polo and pants fabrics that are fast drying will increase your comfort level. It is advised you bring more than one working/field uniform and are prepared to wash those items throughout the week.

Blue Athletics Shorts	As Needed	Preferable navy. Should be no shorter than mid-thigh and no longer than an inch below the knee. May be full length to meet religious standards.

Hair Accessories (Female)	As Needed	As required to meet grooming standards	
Menstrual Supplies	As Needed	High intensity environments can start, increase, or effect menstrual cycles. Females should consider packing more supplies than they are expected to use.	
Blister Care	1	Examples: Spenco Blister Kit, Band-Aid Blister Gel Guard, Dr Scholl's Moleskin, Blister Prevention Patches, Compeed Blister Cushions,	
Flashlight	1	With extra batteries	
Sewing Kit	1	Should include a needle and navy, white, and brown thread	
Shoe Polishing Kit	1	Minimum: black shoe polish and rag to use for polishing. Optional: shoe brush, express polish sponge	
Travel Iron	Optional	We want cadet uniforms to look crisp for graduation. Typically, if each squadron plans for 1 or 2 cadets to bring an iron, that will be plenty.	
Sunglasses	Optional	Must meet uniform standards	
Wrist Watch	Encouraged		
Back-pack	Optional	Must meet uniform standards	
Water Bottle/Hydration Pack	1	Hydration is important and unlike basic cadets you will not be issued a water canteen	
Bedding		TAC Officers will set the best example if they bring the same bedding the basic cadets are required to bring: blue twin blanket, two white twin top sheets, one white pillow case.	
Twin Blanket	1	Sleeping bag is a suitable option	
Twin Sheet(s)	2	If you are choosing a sleeping bag you still need one sheet to cover the mattress	
Pillowcase	1	Each bed has one standard military issue pillow, feel free to bring your own	
Mattress Pad	Optional	The mattress are standard waterproof military issue sitting on camp bed frame	
Civilian Outfit	1	You will likely want to change into civilian clothes before heading home	
Snacks	Optional	Anything you bring must be neatly stored, not make a mess, or be seen by basic cadets	
Electronics	Optional	Phone, camera, tablets	
Charging Cables	Optional	Sometimes outlets are limited you might appreciate bringing a setup that allows you to charge all your devices at once from a single outlet	
Camp Chair	Optional	Sometimes chairs are limited or not available at training locations, you might appreciate having a portable chair you can sometimes carry with you.	
Position Related Material	As Needed	Will vary based on your position. However, basics like note pad/paper, pens/pencils, computer should be considered by all Senior Members
