Athletic Shirt	As Needed	Should be long enough to tuck into bottoms. Preferable grey and free of non-CAP or USAF graphics. May be short or long sleeve, but not a tank-top.	
Athletic Shorts/Leggins	As Needed	Preferable navy and free of non-CAP or USAF graphics. Should be no shorter than mid-thigh and no longer than an inch below the knee. May be full length to meet religious standards.	
Cold Weather Top	Optional	Preferable grey and free of non-CAP or USAF graphics.	
Cold Weather Bottoms	Optional	Preferable navy, conservative, and free of non-CAP or USAF graphics	
White Athletic Socks	As Needed		
Running Shoes	As Needed	Should be broken in to prevent blisters

Bras (Female)	2 min	Suggested minimum: two sports bras. Bring additional sports bras or regular bras based on personal preference

<b>Towel / Shower</b>	1		
<b>Washcloth</b>	Optional		
<b>Shower Shoes</b>	1		
<b>Personal Hygiene Kit</b>	1	As desired	
<b>Sewing Kit</b>	Optional	Should include a needle and navy, white, and brown thread	
<b>Shoe Polishing Kit</b>	Optional	Minimum: black shoe polish and rag to use for polishing. Optional: shoe brush, express polish sponge	
<b>Travel Iron</b>	Optional	We want cadet uniforms to look crisp for graduation. Typically, if each squadron plans for 1 or 2 cadets to bring an iron, that will be plenty.	
<b>Water Bottle/Hydration Pack</b>	Encouraged	Hydration is important and unlike basic cadets you will not be issued a water canteen	
<b>Bedding</b>			
<b>Twin Blanket</b>	1	Sleeping bag is a suitable option	
<b>Twin Sheet(s)</b>	2	If you are choosing a sleeping bag, I suggest you bring a fitted sheet to cover the mattress.	
<b>Pillowcase</b>	1	Each bed has one standard military issue pillow, feel free to bring your own	
<b>Mattress Pad</b>	Optional	The mattress are standard waterproof military issue sitting on camp bed frame	
<b>Civilian Outfit</b>	1	You will likely want to change into civilian clothes before heading home	
<b>Snacks</b>	Optional	Anything you bring must be neatly stored, not make a mess, or be seen by basic cadets	
<b>Electronics</b>	Optional	Phone, camera, tablets	
<b>Charging Cables</b>	Optional	Sometimes outlets are limited you might appreciate bringing a setup that allows you to charge all your devices at once from a single outlet	
<b>Camp Chair</b>	Optional	Sometimes chairs are limited or not available at training locations, you might appreciate having a portable chair you can sometimes carry with you.	
<b>Position Related Material</b>	As Needed	Will vary based on your position. However, basics like note pad/paper, pens/pencils, computer should be considered by all Senior Members	
<b>Prohibited Items</b>	Weapons as specified by CAP regulations, alcohol, illegal drugs, non-prescribed prescription drugs, inappropriate printed or digital material		
<b>Missing Supplies</b>	If you arrive at encampment without something you need there should be time for you to go out to town and purchase it.
